

CLASSROOM SAFETY RULES AND PROCEDURES

(adopted from the Natural Science Dept, NBPS)



1. Do not sit, stand, or lean on the windowsills of the classroom.
2. Do not open the windows.
3. Do not throw ANY objects, e.g. pencils, books, balls, crumpled up paper, etc)
4. Do not touch the teacher's computer, teacher's inbox, or ANYTHING on the teacher's desk.
5. Do not use cell phones in class, not for text messages or conversations. Your phone will be confiscated if you are seen using a phone in class. If your phone rings in class inadvertently, it will be confiscated, so make sure you turn your phone off or to a silent setting before the bell rings.
6. Do not use physical force of any kind.
7. Do not lock the door to the classroom.
8. Do not touch any audio-visual equipment.
9. Do not lie on the floor.
10. NEVER remove your shoes in the lab.
11. Keep all backpacks clear of the aisles; leave a clear path to the exits in case of emergency exits.
12. Always check in with the teacher before an assembly.
13. During fire drills: leave the classroom in an orderly fashion, do not talk, stay with your teacher, and listen carefully for instructions.
